## Camp:

- The Countryside YMCA located in Lebanon, Ohio is a 220,000 sq. ft. facility, built on 126 acres of land
- Weather = In summer the days are warm and the nights can be cool. Bring t-shirts and shorts for daytime and long pants and a light jacket for evening. Full packing list will be provided.
- Activities = With a variety of camp packages available you may find yourself swimming, playing soccer or baseball. Looking for adventure? Try fishing or hiking.
- Education = Some of our students have the opportunity to participate in Camp Discover, a one-of-a-kind camp that couples learning and fun. Mornings include engaging themed activities as campers learn science, history, and art through games, crafts and instruction. Campers spend time each day in our camp shelter and woods hiking, playing in the creek, completing scavenger hunts, and building stick forts. Afternoons include swim time. Some weeks also include fun field



trips filled with inspiring activities and experiences.

## Host Family and US Tour:



- Host Family = Spend two weeks living with a typical American host family. Wake up and have a family style breakfast before departing for camp activities or touring. Most evenings you will come home and join your family for dinner. On occasion you will have a SELT dinner planned as a group at a local restaurant.
- Location = Many host families live in Trenton, Ohio in the Dayton area. Known as The Birthplace of Aviation and so much more! Dayton is home to the Wright Brothers, the Dayton Aviation Heritage National Historical Park and the National Museum of the U.S. Air Force (the world's largest and oldest military aviation museum).
- Located at one of the busiest crossroads of America, it offers world- class attractions, fantastic arts and culture performances; beautiful parks with bike and recreation trails, a variety of activities and shopping a car ride away.
- Activities = You will have one week before or after camp to tour



the local American sights. There are so many activities in the area to enjoy. Based on weather and availability you will experience some of the following: National Museum of the US Air Force, Kings Island: Largest Amusement & Waterpark, American BBQ dinner, Canoeing, Sunwatch Indian Village, Take a ride on the Lebanon Mason Monroe Railroad, Outlet Shopping.
